

JOB DESCRIPTION AND JOB SPECIFICATION

PSYCHOTHERAPY TRAINER/COURSE TUTOR

We are looking for a Trainer/Course Tutor role to teach Transactional Analysis Psychotherapy from an Integrative Perspective to the next intake on the First Year of the 4 Year Transactional Analysis training programme.

Role: to be Course Tutor to the next intake of 1st years onto the 4 year Transactional Analysis Psychotherapy Diploma and to take this group to the end of their four year training. This is in line with the modules already set and established for the tutor to follow. There are eleven weekend modules in the first and second years; in the third and fourth years there are ten weekend modules with two of these being for 3 days (Fri/Sat/Sun, or Sat/Sun/Mon).

Fees: £1000 per weekend plus related admin fees (eg marking of essays).

Person Specification:

The candidate needs to have experience of teaching Transactional Analysis at Post Graduate Level 7.

The candidate needs to be a full clinical member of the UKCP/BACP.

Experience in training groups is paramount.

The candidate also needs to have experience in the area of Psychotherapy Supervision as well as the course training.

The course tutor needs to commit to attendance at Trainers meetings four times a year and be part of the team of trainers at MIP.

As well as being the Course Tutor, the candidate needs to have experience in the administration side of being a course tutor, eg the marking of trainees' essays twice a year, fill out attendance registers etc. There will be remuneration for marking essays.

Commitment to the general workings and ethos of the Manchester Institute.

Personal abilities: To be a good team player, friendly, approachable. Excellent communication skills
